

BIG CAMP FIRE CEREMONIAL SET

Several Hundred to
Take Part in Fete
Sunday.

Several hundred Camp Fire Girls of South Bend will gather in their huge ceremonial circle at 3 o'clock Sunday afternoon in the Riley High school gymnasium for their semi-annual council fire.

The program, which is open without charge to all persons interested in the Camp Fire organization, will open with the bugle call; the entrance of flags, including the United States flag, the American Red Cross flag and the Camp Fire flag, borne by Jeanne and Patricia Andres and Helene Zigler; the entrance of guardians and the entrance of the girls.

Following an invocation the girls will give the salute to the flag, will sing "America the Beautiful" and give the Camp Fire hand sign and law.
